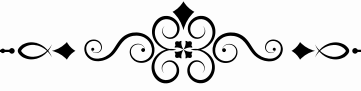

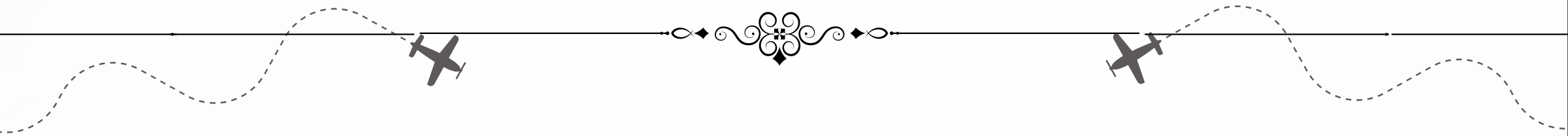
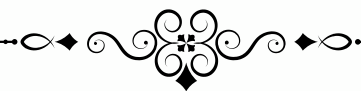

# Arrive Delhi

*Delhi, India's modern capital, is an ancient city tracing its origins in legend – dotted with hundreds of landmarks and offering more than a millennium of history in stone.*

## Arrival & Transfer

- Arrive at Delhi at Indira Gandhi International Airport – the busiest airport in India and seventh busiest in the world, handling almost 68 million passengers annually
- Your customs and immigration formalities will take approximately one hour
- You'll be greeted and met by our representative just after baggage collection, holding the company's paging board with your name on it
- You'll be assisted and transferred to your hotel in Delhi
- Check-in at the hotel and freshen up after your journey
- Stay overnight at the hotel in Delhi

- Delhi is India's vibrant capital – a city of extraordinary contrasts where ancient history and modern life collide
- The city traces its origins back over 5,000 years and has served as the capital of several empires

- A city where Mughal emperors built their empires, Rajput kings held court, and British colonials left their indelible mark

# Delhi Sightseeing

## Morning — New Delhi

- Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel
- After breakfast, meet your driver and city guide and begin sightseeing in New Delhi
- Lodhi Gardens 4 One of Delhi's favourite spots for morning walkers, joggers, and yoga enthusiasts, set amid the atmospheric tombs of the Sayyid and Lodi dynasties (15th-16th century); a peaceful green oasis in the heart of the city
- Humayun's Tomb 4 Built in 1570, this was the first garden-tomb on the Indian subcontinent and is considered the architectural predecessor of the Taj Mahal; a UNESCO World Heritage Site of immense cultural significance
- Qutab Minar 4 Built at the site of Lal Kot, the first city of Delhi; this 73-metre minaret is a UNESCO World Heritage Site that marks the arrival of Islamic rule in India; surrounded by the ruins of the Quwwat-ul-Islam mosque
- Enjoy your lunch at a restaurant of your choice or discuss options with your city guide

## Afternoon & Evening — Old Delhi

- Postlunch: explore the legacy of the British Raj 4 drive past the grand British Colonial Buildings including President's House (Rashtrapati Bhavan), Parliament House, India Gate, Raj Path (King's Way), Janpath (Queen's Way), government official bungalows, and Connaught Place
- Reach Old Delhi and explore the old city by walking or rickshaw ride through its labyrinthine lanes
- Jama Masjid 4 the largest mosque in India, built by Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan; can accommodate 25,000 worshippers at a time
- Gurudwara Sees Ganj Sahib 4 a historic Sikh temple marking the martyrdom of Guru Tegh Bahadur
- Chandni Chowk 4 one of the oldest and busiest markets in India; home to silversmiths, repair shops, clothiers, spicy street food vendors, and traditional sweetmeat shops

Explore not just the bazaar but the entire cultural landscape of Old

- Delhi 4 full of smells, sights & sounds that will leave you overwhelmed

Late evening optional: visit Akshardham Temple (one of the world's

- largest Hindu temples) or stroll through Dilli Haat (Handicraft Bazaar)

Dinner at a restaurant of your choice or at the hotel; overnight in Delhi

DAY 03

# Delhi to Jaipur — The Pink City

235 km • 4 Hours Drive

## Morning — Drive to Jaipur

- Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel
- After breakfast, check out and drive with your driver to Jaipur — known as the Pink City of India
- 4-hour scenic drive through the landscape of Rajasthan
- You'll arrive in Jaipur by late afternoon; check in at your hotel and relax
- Your driver will take you out for lunch at one of the popular restaurants in Jaipur — alternatively, you can stop for lunch en route before checking in at the hotel
- Return to the hotel after lunch and relax

## Evening — Sanganer & Local Cooking Experience

- Evening: meet your guide and visit Sanganer — a town famous for its textile printing industry, handmade paper industry, and beautiful Jain temples
- The style of Sanganer fabric prints is one of a kind — patterns are made in bright colours and are typically printed on white or off-white backgrounds; a living craft tradition passed down through generations
- Tonight, you'll visit a local home to learn Indian cooking — participate in a hands-on cooking demonstration with a local family and enjoy a traditional home-cooked dinner in their home in Jaipur
- This is one of the most authentic and memorable cultural experiences of the entire journey — a rare window into everyday Indian family life
- Return to the hotel and stay overnight in Jaipur

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# Jaipur Sightseeing – The Pink City

## Morning – Monuments & Palaces

- Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel
- After breakfast, meet your driver and city guide for a full day of sightseeing in Jaipur
- Amer Fort – The traditional fortress of the Kacchawaha Rajput kings at Amber; a beautiful citadel rich in stories of valour perched on a hilltop overlooking Maota Lake; explore the ornate Sheesh Mahal (Mirror Palace), Diwan-i-Khas, Sukh Niwas, and the Ganesh Pol gateway
- City Palace Museum – A royal residence and former administrative headquarters of the rulers of the Jaipur state in Rajasthan; houses a remarkable collection of royal artefacts, textiles, weapons, and manuscripts across its many courtyards and galleries
- Jantar Mantar (Observatory) – A collection of 19 astronomical instruments built by Rajput king Sawai Jai Singh, the founder of Jaipur state; contains the world's largest stone sundial (Samrat Yantra) and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Hawa Mahal (Wind Palace) – Built from red and pink sandstone, this iconic five-storey palace with 953 small latticed windows (jharokhas) was designed to allow royal ladies to observe street life and festivals unseen; one of Jaipur's most photographed landmarks
- Enjoy your lunch at a restaurant of your choice or discuss options with your city guide

## Afternoon & Evening – Walled City

- Post lunch: continue sightseeing in the walled city of Jaipur
- You will be shown not only the monuments and palaces of this legendary wealthy city, but also the temples, crafts, and guilds patronised by the rulers over centuries
- Rickshaw ride through the walled city of Jaipur – an exhilarating way to experience the narrow lanes, colourful bazaars, and the living heritage of the Pink City
- Explore the spices, sweets, and colourful bazaars – Johari Bazaar (jewellery), Bapu Bazaar (textiles), Nehru Bazaar (mojri shoes), and Tripolia Bazaar (lac bangles and metalwork)
- After completing the sightseeing, return to your hotel by late evening to relax
- Your driver will take you out for dinner at a restaurant of your choice
- Return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Jaipur

DAY 05

# Jaipur to Agra via Fatehpur Sikri & Abhaneri Stepwell

250 km · 4.5 Hours Drive

## Morning — Optional Activities & Departure

- Optional morning activities before departure:
  - Hot air balloon ride — fly above Hawa Mahal, Amer Fort and Samode Palace for a 360-degree view of the Pink City
  - Or bathe the elephants at Dera Amer — a unique and memorable experience
- After breakfast, check out and drive towards Agra — the City of the Taj Mahal
- En route, stop to visit the Abhaneri Stepwell (Chand Baori) — one of the most beautiful and largest stepwells in the world, with 3,500 narrow steps arranged in perfect geometric symmetry descending 13 storeys into the earth

## Afternoon — Fatehpur Sikri & Agra

- Continue driving and stop at Fatehpur Sikri — the abandoned Mughal capital city, a UNESCO World Heritage Site; explore the Buland Darwaza (Gate of Victory), Jama Masjid, Tomb of Salim Chishti, and the royal palaces (allow approximately 2 hours)
- Enjoy lunch at Fatehpur Sikri before resuming the drive to Agra
- Arrive in Agra by late afternoon; check in at your hotel and relax
- Evening: meet your guide and driver to visit Itimad-ud-Daulah (Baby Taj) — a Mughal mausoleum on the western bank of the Yamuna River, also known as the Jewel Box; a smaller but exquisitely ornate precursor to the Taj Mahal
- Sunset view of the Taj Mahal from Mehtab Bagh on the opposite bank of the Yamuna River
- Shopping and dinner at a restaurant of your choice; overnight in Agra

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DAY 06

# Agra to Chambal – Taj Mahal at Sunrise & Gharial Safari

60 km • 1.5 Hours Drive

## Morning – Taj Mahal at Sunrise & Agra Fort

- Early morning: meet your city guide and driver for a sunrise view of the Taj Mahal – one of the most breathtaking sights in the world as the white marble glows golden in the first light of dawn
- Return to the hotel for breakfast
- Post breakfast: visit Agra Fort – a UNESCO World Heritage Site built by three generations of Mughal Emperors; Akbar built the walls and gates, his grandson Shah Jahan erected many of the ethereal buildings inside, and his great-grandson Aurangzeb built the outer ramparts
- Explore the Diwan-i-Am (Hall of Public Audience), Diwan-i-Khas (Hall of Private Audience), Khas Mahal, and the Musamman Burj – the tower from which Shah Jahan spent his final years gazing at the Taj Mahal

## Afternoon – Drive to Chambal & Gharial Breeding Centre

- After saying goodbye to your guide, drive 1.5 hours to Dholpur (Chambal)
- Arrive at Dholpur and check in at the Palace Hotel; enjoy lunch and rest
- Around 3:30 pm, drive 30 minutes to the Eco Park Deori – Gharial Breeding Centre; Gharials are bred in captivity here and grown for two to three years before release into the wild (note: centre closes at 5:00 pm)
- Gharials are the world's longest crocodylians – fish-eating reptiles with a distinctive long, narrow snout
- Return to the Palace Hotel after the visit
- Enjoy evening activities organised by the hotel; dinner and overnight at the Palace Hotel in Chambal

DAY 07

# Chambal to Orchha via Gwalior — The City of Music

185 km · 4 Hours Drive

## Morning — Chambal River Boat Safari

- Early morning: take a packed breakfast and enjoy a morning boat safari on the Chambal River — the best way to experience the Chambal Sanctuary
- Experience the magnificent ravines on one side of the bank and thriving wildlife on the other; the safari lasts one hour and takes you deep into the riverbed
- Spot Gharials (fish-eating crocodiles), Muggers Crocodiles, freshwater turtles, Gangetic River Dolphins, and close to 300 species of resident and migratory birds including the rare Indian Skimmer
- Return to the hotel, check out and begin your 2-hour drive to Gwalior — the City of Music

## Afternoon — Gwalior & Orchha

- Arrive Gwalior; enjoy lunch at a popular restaurant
- Meet your guide and visit Gwalior Fort — known as the "Pearl amongst Fortresses in India"; a magnificent hilltop citadel with palaces, temples, and water tanks dating back to the 8th century
- Visit the Sun Temple — a stunning replica of the famous Konark Sun Temple of Odisha
- Continue your 2-hour drive to Orchha — the Hidden City, known for its temples, monuments, and folklore
- Arrive in Orchha by late evening; check in at your hotel and relax
- Dinner at the hotel; overnight in Orchha

DAY 08

# Orchha to Khajuraho – The Erotic Temples

175 km • 3 Hours Drive

## Morning – Orchha Sightseeing

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel
- Meet your guide and begin exploring the hidden city of Orchha
- Orchha Fort Complex & witness several historical monuments within the complex; explore the ancient temples and royal palaces including Raja Mahal, Jahangir Mahal, and Rai Praveen Mahal
- Lakshmi Narayan Temple & dedicated to Lord Vishnu (Narayan) and Goddess Lakshmi; famous for its extraordinary paintings and murals depicting scenes from the Ramayana and Mahabharata
- Ram Raja Temple & the only temple in India where Lord Ram is worshipped as a king
- Chaturbhuj Temple & a magnificent stone temple with a soaring spire visible from miles around
- After sightseeing, collect your luggage and check out of the hotel

## Afternoon & Evening – Khajuraho

- Drive 3 hours to Khajuraho & one of the most famous UNESCO World Heritage Sites in India
- Khajuraho's magnificent temples are principally noted for their extraordinary erotic sculptures & a celebration of life, love, and the divine; built between 950-1050 AD by the Chandela dynasty
- Enjoy lunch before entering Khajuraho city
- Check in at your hotel and rest
- Evening: your driver will take you to the temples for the famous Sound & Light Show & a spectacular event that brings to life the history, facts, and myths of the Khajuraho temples through dramatic narration and illumination
- Dinner at a popular restaurant near the temple area; overnight in Khajuraho

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DAY 09

# Khajuraho to Bandhavgarh National Park

250 km · 5.5 Hours Drive

## Morning — Khajuraho Temple Exploration

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel
- Meet your guide and driver to visit the Western and Eastern ranges of the Khajuraho Temples
- Western Group — the most celebrated temples including Kandariya Mahadeva Temple (the largest and most ornate), Lakshmana Temple, Vishvanatha Temple, and Chitragupta Temple; all adorned with intricate carvings of celestial beings, warriors, and erotic sculptures
- Eastern Group — Jain temples including Parsvanatha Temple, known for its exquisite carvings
- Visit the local bazaar area — Khajuraho is a small town where tourism is the main livelihood; explore local crafts, stone carvings, and souvenirs
- Return to the hotel after sightseeing and check out

## Afternoon — Drive to Bandhavgarh

- Drive 5.5 hours to Bandhavgarh National Park — renowned as the best place in India for Tiger sightings; the park has one of the highest densities of Bengal Tigers in the world
- Arrive at Bandhavgarh; check in at your jungle resort and relax for the day
- The park is also home to leopards, sloth bears, wild dogs (dholes), gaur (Indian bison), sambar deer, spotted deer, and over 250 species of birds
- Evening: enjoy dinner at the jungle resort and retire early to prepare for your early morning game drive
- Overnight at the jungle resort in Bandhavgarh

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DAY 10

# Tiger Safaris at Bandhavgarh National Park

## Morning Game Drive

- Wake up early and meet your naturalist and driver for a morning game drive into Bandhavgarh National Park
- Bandhavgarh is India's premier tiger reserve – with one of the highest tiger densities in the world, sightings are almost guaranteed
- The park's diverse zones – Tala, Magdhi, and Khitauli – offer varied habitats from dense sal forests to open meadows
- Look out for Bengal Tigers, Leopards, Sloth Bears, Gaur (Indian Bison), Wild Dogs (Dholes), Sambar Deer, Spotted Deer, Nilgai, and a rich variety of birdlife
- Return to the jungle resort after the safari and enjoy breakfast
- Relax through the afternoon; lunch served at the jungle resort
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## Afternoon Game Drive & Evening

- Late afternoon: meet your naturalist and driver for an afternoon game drive into Bandhavgarh National Park – the golden hour light makes for spectacular wildlife photography
- Tigers are often more active in the late afternoon as they emerge from the shade to hunt
- After the safari, return to the jungle resort and freshen up
- Evening: enjoy a bonfire with fellow guests at the jungle resort – share the day's sightings and experiences around the fire
- Dinner at the jungle resort; overnight in Bandhavgarh

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DAY 11

# Bandhavgarh to Kanha National Park

250 km • 5 Hours Drive

## Morning — Final Safari & Departure

- Wake up early and meet your naturalist and driver for one final morning game drive into Bandhavgarh National Park — a last chance to spot the majestic tigers in their natural habitat
- After the safari, return to the jungle resort and enjoy breakfast
- Check out and meet your driver for the 5-hour drive to Kanha National Park
- Your resort will provide a packed lunch for the journey
- Kanha National Park — one of India's most scenic national parks, famous for tiger sightings and its sweeping landscapes of sal and bamboo forests, open meadows, and meandering streams

## Evening — Arrive Kanha

- Kanha is the inspiration for Rudyard Kipling's famous novel 'The Jungle Book' — the very forests where the character Mowgli roamed
- The park is home to Bengal Tigers, Leopards, Barasingha (Swamp Deer — Kanha's signature species, saved from extinction here), Gaur, Wild Dogs, Sloth Bears, and over 300 species of birds
- Arrive in Kanha National Park by evening; check in at your jungle resort and relax
- Evening: enjoy dinner at the jungle resort and retire early to prepare for your early morning game drive
- Overnight at the jungle resort in Kanha

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DAY 12

# Tiger Safaris at Kanha National Park

## Morning Game Drive

- Wake up early and meet your naturalist and driver for a morning game drive into Kanha National Park
- Kanha's vast landscape of sal forests, bamboo groves, and open meadows (called maidans) provides the perfect setting for wildlife encounters
- The park is divided into the Kanha and Kisli zones — your naturalist will guide you to the best areas for tiger activity
- Look out for Bengal Tigers, Leopards, Barasingha (Hard Ground Swamp Deer), Gaur (Indian Bison), Wild Dogs (Dholes), Sloth Bears, Sambar Deer, Spotted Deer, and a spectacular array of birds
- Return to the jungle resort after the safari and enjoy breakfast
- Relax through the afternoon; lunch served at the jungle resort

## Afternoon Game Drive & Evening

- Late afternoon: meet your naturalist and driver for an afternoon game drive into Kanha National Park
- The Kanha meadows are particularly magical at dusk — herds of deer graze in the golden light while predators begin to stir
- After the safari, return to the jungle resort and freshen up
- Evening: enjoy a bonfire with fellow guests — share the day's wildlife encounters and stories from the jungle
- Your naturalist will give an informal talk on the ecology and conservation of Kanha's wildlife
- Dinner at the jungle resort; overnight in Kanha

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DAY 13

# Kanha to Pench National Park — The Jungle Book Territory

224 km • 5 Hours Drive

## Morning — Final Kanha Safari & Departure

- Wake up early and meet your naturalist and driver for one final morning game drive into Kanha National Park — a last opportunity to witness the wild charisma of the majestic tigers
- After the safari, return to the jungle resort and enjoy breakfast
- Check out and meet your driver for the 5-hour drive to Pench National Park
- Your resort will provide a packed lunch for the journey
- Pench National Park — an impeccable place to walk down the memory lanes of your childhood; this is the very forest that inspired Rudyard Kipling's immortal story 'The Jungle Book' and the character of Wolf Child Mowgli

## Evening — Arrive Pench

- Pench straddles the states of Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra; the Madhya Pradesh side is the more famous for tiger sightings
- The park is named after the Pench River that flows through it, creating a rich riparian habitat
- Wildlife includes Bengal Tigers, Leopards, Wild Dogs (Dholes), Gaur, Sambar Deer, Spotted Deer, Nilgai, and over 285 species of birds
- Arrive in Pench National Park by evening; check in at your jungle resort and relax
- Evening: enjoy dinner at the jungle resort and retire early to prepare for your early morning game drive
- Overnight at the jungle resort in Pench

DAY 14

# Tiger Safaris at Pench National Park – Mowgli's Jungle

## Morning Game Drive

- Wake up early and meet your naturalist and driver for a morning game drive into Pench National Park
- Pench's landscape of teak and mixed forests, interspersed with grassy clearings and the Pench River, creates a magical setting straight out of The Jungle Book
- The park's tigers are known to be bold and frequently spotted – your naturalist will track pugmarks and use alarm calls from deer and langurs to locate them
- Look out for Bengal Tigers, Leopards, Wild Dogs (Dholes), Gaur, Sambar Deer, Spotted Deer, Nilgai, Sloth Bears, and a spectacular variety of birds including the Indian Pitta, Crested Serpent Eagle, and Malabar Pied Hornbill
- Return to the jungle resort after the safari and enjoy breakfast
- Relax through the afternoon; lunch served at the jungle resort

## Afternoon Game Drive & Evening

- Late afternoon: meet your naturalist and driver for an afternoon game drive into Pench National Park
- The Pench River and its banks are particularly productive for wildlife sightings in the late afternoon – predators come to drink and hunt
- After the safari, return to the jungle resort and freshen up
- Evening: enjoy a bonfire with fellow guests – share the day's wildlife encounters and relive the magic of Mowgli's jungle
- Your naturalist will share fascinating stories about the tigers and wildlife of Pench
- Dinner at the jungle resort; overnight in Pench

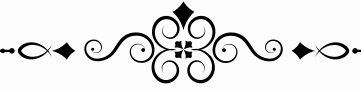
